(2:118) And those who have no knowledge say: Why does not Allah speak to us in our language? — (2:119) — Surely We have sent them with the Truth as a guidance ^{and a reminder} for man.

(17:105) And that thou set thy purpose towards the Religion uprightly; and be not of the polytheists.

(11:54) He said: Surely I call Allah to witness, and do you, too, bear witness that I am innocent of what you associate (with Allah).

(12:38) “— It beseems us not to associate ought with Allah. This is by Allah's grace upon us and on mankind, but most people give not thanks.

(12:106) And most of them believe not in Allah without associating others (with Him).

(12:107) Do they then feel secure from the Coming to them of an all-encompassing chastisement from Allah or from the Coming to them of the Hour suddenly, while they perceive not?

(12:108) Say: This is my way: I call to Allah, with certain knowledge — I and those who follow me. And Glory be to Allah! and I am not of the polytheists.

(16:1) Glory be to Him, and highly exalted be He above what they associate (with Him).

(16:3) He Created the heavens and the earth with truth. Highly exalted be He above what they associate (with Him).

وَلَمْ يُرْجِعُوا إِلَيْهِ مَا سَرَفُوا وَلَمْ يُنْهَا رُحْبَانٌ
 (10:55) And the idolaters say: Had Allah pleased, we had not served
 aught but Him, (neither) we nor our fathers, nor had we prohibited
 aught without (order from) Him. Thus did those before them.
 But have the messengers any duty except a plain
 delivery (of the message)?

(16:36) And certainly We raised in every nation a messenger,
 saying: Serve Allah and shun the devil. Then of them was he
 whom Allah guided, and of them was he whose remaining in
 error was justly due. So travel in the land, then see what
 was the end of the rejectors -'

(16:54,55) Then when He removes the evil from ~~them~~ you, lo!
 some of you associate others with their Lord,
 so as to deny what We have given them. Then enjoy
 yourselves, for soon will you know.

(16:56) And they set apart for what they know not, a portion of
 what we have given them. By Allah! you shall certainly
 be questioned about that which you forged.

(16:86) And when those who ascribe partners (to Allah) see their
 , 87 associates, they will say: Our Lord, these are our associate
 gods on whom we called besides Thee. But they will throw
 back at them the word: Surely you are liars.

- (16:87) And they will tender submission to Allah on that day, and what they used to forge will fail them.
- (16:100) ^{Devils} His authority is only over those who befriend him and those who associate others with Him.
- (16:99) Surely He has no authority over those who believe and rely on their Lord.
- (17:64) ... and share with them in wealth and children, and promise them. And the devil promises them only to decoy.
- (17:65) My servants - thou hast surely no authority over them. And thy Lord suffices as having charge of affairs.
- (17:111) And say: Praise be to Allah! Who has not taken to himself a son, and Who has not a partner in the Kingdom, and Who has not a helper because of weakness; and proclaim His greatness, magnifying (Him).
- (18:38) But as for me, He, Allah, is my Lord, and I associate none with my Lord.
- (18:42) ... and he said: Ah me! would that I had ascribed no partners to my Lord!
- (18:52) And one day He will say: Call on those whom you ^{considered} considered to be My partners. So they will call on them, but they will not answer them, and We shall cause a separation between them.

- (18: 110) "... So whoever hopes to meet his Lord, he should do good deeds, and join no one in service of his Lord."
- (17: 35) "It be seems not Allah that He should take to Himself a Son. Glory be to Him! when He decrees a matter He only says to it, Be, and it is."
- (19: 36) And surely Allah is my Lord and your Lord, so serve Him. This is the right path.
- (19: 88) And they say: The Beneficent has taken to Himself a son.

- (20: 85) -and the Sanirī has led them astray - -
- 20: 90) And Aaron indeed had said to them before:

- (21: 52) -- What are these images to whose whose worship you cleave.
- (22: 26) And when We pointed to Abraham the place of the House, saying: Associate naught with Me and purify My House for those who make Circuits and stand to pray and bow and prostrate themselves.
- (22: 31) Being upright for Allah, not associating naught with Him. And whoever associate (naught) with Allah, it is as if he had fallen from on high, then the birds had snatched him away, or the wind had carried him off to a distant place.

- (24:3) The adulterer cannot have sexual relations with any but an adulteress or an idolatress, and the adulteress, none can have sexual relations with her but an adulterer or an idolater, and it is forbidden to believers.
- (24:55) ... They will serve Me, not associating aught with Me. And whoever is ungrateful after this, they are the transgressors.
- (25:2) He, whose is the Kingdom of heaven, and the earth, and Who did not take to Himself a Son, and Who has no associates in the Kingdom, and Who created everything, then ordained for it a measure.
- (25:18) They will say: Glory be to Thee! it was not becoming befitting for us that we should take for protectors others besides Thee, but Thou didst make them and their fathers to enjoy until they forgot the Reminder, and they became a lost people.
- (27:59) - Is Allah better, or what they associate (with Him)
 till 66)
- (27:63) - ... Exalted be Allah above what what they associate (with Him)

(28:62) "And the day when He will call them and say: Where are those whom you deemed to be my associates.

(28:64) And it will be said: Call your associate-gods. So they will call upon them, but they will not answer them, and they will see the Chastisement. Would that they had followed the right way.

(28:68) - Glory be to Allah and exalted be He above what they associate (with Him).

(28:74) "And the day when He will call them and say: Where are My associates whom you pretended.

(28:87) And let them not turn thee aside from the messages of Allah after they have been revealed to thee, and call (men) to thy Lord and be not of the polytheists.

(29:8) ... But if they contend with thee to associate (others) with Me, of which thou hast no knowledge, obey them not. To me is your return, so I will inform you what you did.

(30:28) He sets forth to you a parable relating to ^{yourself} ~~yourself~~. Have you among those whom your right hands possess partners in that which We have provided you with, so that with respect to it you are alike - you fear them as you fear each other? Thus do We make the messages clear for a people

who understand.'

- (30:31) ... and keep up prayer and be not of the polytheists
- (30:33) And when harm afflicts man, they call upon their Lord, turning to Him then when He makes them taste of mercy from Him, lo! some of them begin to associate (others) with their Lord.
- (30:35) Or, have We sent to them an authority so that it speaks of that which they associate with Him?
- (30:40) Allah is He Who created you, then He sustains you, then He causes you to die, then brings you to life. Is there any of your associate-gods who does any of it? Glory be to Him, and exalted be He above what they associate with Him.
- (30:42) Say: Travel in the land, then see what was the end of those before! Most of them were polytheists.
- (31:13) And when Lameen said to his son, while he admonished him: O my son, ascribe no partners to Allah. Surely ascribing partners (to Him) is a grievous iniquity.
- (31:15) And if they strive with thee to make their associates with Me that of which thou hast no knowledge, obey them not, and keep kindly company with them in this world, and follow the way of him who turns to Me; then if no in your return, then I shall inform you of what you did.

- (34:22) 'Say : Call upon those whom you assert besides Allah ; they control not the weight of an atom in the heavens or in the earth, nor have they any partnership in either, nor has He a helper among them.
- (34:27) 'Say : Show me those whom you join with Him as associates - By no means (can you)! Nay, He is Allah, the Mighty, the Wise.
- (34:14) --- And on the day of Resurrection they will deny your associating them (with Allah). And none can inform thee like me the All-Aware One.
- (34:40) 'Say : Have you seen your associates which you call upon besides Allah ? Show me what they have created of the earth ! Or have they any share in the heavens ? Or, have We given them a Book so that they follow a clear argument thereof ? Nay the wrongdoers hold out promises one to another only to deceive.
- (37:22) Gather together those who did wrong and their associates, and what they worshipped.
- (37:85) When he said to his son and his people : What is that you worship ?
- (39:3) And those who choose protectors besides Him (say) : We ~~serve~~^{serve} them only that they may bring us nearer to Allah . Surely Allah will judge between them in that in which

they differ. Surely Allah guides not him who is a liar, ungrateful.

(39:4) If Allah desired to take a son to Himself, He could have chosen those He pleased out of those whom He has created—Glory be to Him! He is Allah, the One, the Subduer (of all).

(39:29) Allah sets forth a parable: A man belonging to partners differing with one another, a man (devoted) wholly to one man. Are the two alike in condition? Praise be to Allah! Nay, most of them know not.

(39:38) And if thou ask them, who created the heavens and the earth? They will say Allah. Say: See you then that those you call upon besides Allah, would they, if Allah desires to afflict me with harm, remove His harm? Or if He desires to show me mercy, could they withhold His mercy? Say: Allah is sufficient for me. On Him do the Reliant rely.

(39:43) Or take they intercessors besides Allah? Say: What! Even though they control naught, nor do they understand?

(39:45) And when Allah alone is mentioned, the hearts of those who believe not in the Hereafter shrink, and when those besides Him are mentioned, lo! they are joyful.

- (40:12) That is because when alone was called upon, you disbelieved, and when associates were called given to Him, you believed. So judgment belongs to Allah, the High, the Great.
- (40:73) Then it is said to them: Where is that which you used
, 74 to set up besides Allah
- (40:84) 'So when they saw Our punishment they said: We believe
in Allah Alone, and we deny what we used to associate with Him.
- (41:6) And woe to the polytheists! who give not the poor rats
and who are disbelievers in the Hereafter.
- (41:9) Say: Do you indeed disbelieve in Him Who created
the earth in two days, and do you set up equals with Him?
- (42:6) And those who take protectors besides Him - Allah watches
over them; and thou hast no charge over them.
- (42:7) 'Or have they taken protectors besides Him? But Allah
is the Protector, and He gives life to the dead, and He
is Possessor of power over all things.
- (45:10) In front of them is hell, and that which they have
earned will avail them naught, nor those whom they
take for protectors besides Allah, and for them is a
grievous Chastisement.

- (46:4) Say: Have you considered that which you invoke besides Allah? Show me what they have created of the earth, or have they a share in the heavens? Bring me a Book before this or any relics of knowledge, if you are truthful.
- (60:4) Indeed, there is for you a good example in Abraham and those with him, when they said to their people: We are clear of you and of what which you serve besides Allah. We disbelieve in you and there has arisen enmity and hatred between us and you forever until you believe in Allah alone — except Abraham's saying to his son —
- (66:41) Or have they associate-gods? Then let them bring their associates, if they are truthful.
- (72:2) And we shall not set up any one with our Lord.
- (72:20) Say: I only call upon my Lord, and associate naught with Him.

(58:21) O you who believe, when you consult the Messenger, Offer Something in charity before your consultation. That is better for you & prouer.

(59:18) O you who believe, keep your duty to Allah, and let every soul consider that which it sends forth for the morrow, and keep your duty to Allah.

(60:1) O you who believe, take not My enemy and your enemy for friends. Would you offer them love while they deny the Truth that has come to you, driving out the Messenger and yourselves because you believe in Allah, your Lord? If you have come forth to strive in My way and to seek My pleasure, would you love them in secret? I know what you conceal and what you manifest—

(60:10) O you who believe, when believing women come to you fleeing, examine them. Allah knows best their faith. Then if you know them to be believers send them not back to the disbelievers

- (60:13) O you who believe, take note: for friends a people with whom Allah is wroth — they indeed despair of the Hereafter, as the disbelievers despair of those in the graves.
- (61:2) O you who believe, Why say you that which you do not?
- (61:10) O you who believe, Shall I lead you to merchandise which will deliver you from a painful chastisement? You should believe in Allah and His Messenger, and strive hard in Allah's way with your wealth and your lives. That is better for you, did you but know!
- (61:11) O you who believe, be helpers (in the cause) of Allah, as Jesus, Son of Mary, said to his disciples: Who are my helpers in the cause of Allah? (64:14) O you who believe, Surely your wives and your children are enemies to you, so beware of them. And if you pardon and forbear and forgive, surely Allah is Forgiving, Merciful.

(66:6) O you who believe, Save yourselves and your families from a Fire whose fuel is men and stones; over it are angels, stern & strong. They do not disobey Allah in
